

Recommended Qualification Structure for Demolition (Construction) Level 3 **proposed 141019**

This structure has been recommended by employers and stakeholders from the above occupational area for organisations to form the basis of academic capability and competence outcomes. Qualifications with a competence outcome at the above level must have units derived from the following National Occupational Standards (NOS) and consist of the mandatory/optional groups as stated for the individual option route.

MANDATORY (all option routes)

- VR209 v2 Confirm work activities and resources for the work
- VR210 v3 Develop and maintain good working relationships
- VR211 v2 Confirm the occupational method of work
- VR641 v2 Conform to general workplace health, safety and welfare
- VR763 ? Install, construct, maintain, dismantle and remove temporary works
- ~~VR212 v2 Implement and maintain health, safety and welfare~~
- ~~VR213 v2 Co-ordinate and organise work operations~~

PLUS ONE OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONAL ROUTES

Demolition (Top Man) Operative (9)

Mandatory

- VR154 v2 Remove and segregate components and materials in demolition

Plus optional (three from the following)

Additional for Demolition Supervisor option (not compulsory)

VR718 v2 — Hand over property
